This year, visitors will rediscover the story of the Little Prince through new and original shows, which embody the hero! Immersed in the story of the main character by Saint-Exupéry, they will meet some extraordinary characters.

### **Festive evenings throughout the season.**

On the strength of its success, the last events organized by the Parc du Parc du Petit Prince saw record numbers of visitors. The Team of the Parc du Petit Prince is preparing for 2022, five festive nights and themed events for the night, and the same price for everyone: 17€ per person (May 20th, June 24th, July 9th, August 6th and October 31st).

### **Interstice, a new interactive show which immerses visitors in the heart of the novel**

### **The Planet of the Animals, a funny and poetic show**

In this new show, come and discover the animals of the tale in a funny and poetic show. You will be amazed by this aerie and terrestrial ballet full of sweetness!

### **Metamorphosis has changed !**

The attraction "metamorphosis" is changing. Now, it houses a studio dedicated to makeup and takes a photo of you with your favourite characters from the novel of the Little Prince.

Moreover, thanks to the end of health restrictions, the Little Theatre and its puppet show is so appreciated by the children.



**Come and discover the favourite attractions of the whole family!**

**About the attractions: aerial thrills throughout the Park**

- A tethered balloon with a flight up to 150m over the ground,
- The aerobar of the drunkard, to take a drink in the air up to 35m over the ground,
- The snake is a roller-coaster which takes place in the desert,
- The Atlantic South, for diving in the water on board an Aéropostal seaplane
- The thunderstone, a spinning roller-coaster

**About the animals: emotions, new encounters, discovering of its lifestyle in its natural space**

Foxes, sheep, acrobatic pigeons, mini farms of one hectare, the Parc du Petit prince allows its visitors to discover again all the animals from the novel as you have never seen them.
